Here are some suggestions for walks during the Summer School.

Interested members, please consult between yourselves!



1. **Nangara Reserve**, Jacksons Track, Jindivick. It is located in fairly steep environs.
2. **Cannibal Creek** . Turn North off Princes Freeway towards Garfield North. Cannibal Creek Reserve turnoff is 2.5k from the Freeway, then take RH turn. Sign is easy to miss.
3. **Noojee railway Bridge**. Walk into Noojee, have a coffee or lunch or both and walk back to bridge.
4. **Blue Rock Dam**. Apparently good for a picnic.
5. **Mt. Worth**. I believe there are some short walks at Mt Worth
6. **Linear Trail**, Warragul. Start at Burke Street, opposite the Leisure Centre, and walk through to Warragul North.
7. **Drouin to Warragul** walk one way and return by train.
8. **Toorong Falls**. Via Noojee. Quite a long drive but worth it.
