- 4. Submit the Form to the Courses Coordinator for consideration by the Courses Committee.
- 5. The Courses Committee may seek more information, approve it in principle, or approve it for inclusion in the program.

The Course Proposal Form is designed to help you think about what needs to be considered in running a course. If you are willing to offer to run a course, no matter whether you are thinking about a short course of a week or two or something a bit more ambitious, please feel free to talk with the Courses Coordinator or a member of the Courses Committee.
